##### **NEW CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT**

For 2008 the YMX committee decided to alter the format for our championship in order to give our young riders more bike time and also to raise the profile of the championship.

Each Round will be run over 2 days (It has yet to be confirmed whether we can run the Dunblane round over two days). Saturday will see all registered youth championship classes get practice/qualifying plus three races. Sunday will see the Adult 125cc Scottish Championship class get practice and three races, with the youth riders getting a sighting lap plus two further races. On each round, riders can drop the worst score from the five races.

On the final round, registered riders who have CONTESTED ALL ROUNDS will receive a free entry, plus double points.

##### **COST**

Registration for the championship will be £5. Each round of the championship will be £42.00 Registration forms will be available at Rd 1 Leuchars. Or download from [www.scottishmotocross.co.uk](http://www.scottishmotocross.co.uk) and bring with you.

##### **TRANSPONDERS**

All clubs are now exclusively using transponders for Scottish Championship events. You must have a transponder and it must be registered to you if you wish to score Scottish Championship points. These can be bought from SACU (01506 858354) **It is your responsibility to make sure they are fully charged and fully operational!**

##### **PRESS REPORTS/PR**

Neil Adamson will do reports and PR for the YMX Scottish Championship. If you have any stories of note or any relevant information, speak to Neil. He will send the report to TMX, and local papers. He will also endeavour to gain TV and radio coverage for each round. Make sure you and your bike looks good – you never know when the TV cameras might pop up!

##### **PHOTOGRAPHER**

Nick Douglas will again be Official Photographer for the Championship. He will work with Neil to ensure we get as much coverage as possible for each round.

##### **CHILD PROTECTION**

Shirley Inglis will be our Child Protection Officer. Any relevant concerns should be reported to either the Clerk of the Course on the event, or direct to Shirley. Please note that any abuse towards riders will not be tolerated, in accordance with the SACU Child Protection Policy.
