

SYMCC club round 2 – Shiplaw 13/6/10

Report

Scottish Youth Motocross Club had round 2 of its club championship, held at Shiplaw near Peebles in the Scottish Borders, last weekend. The track was in perfect condition, rain the week before had soaked the track, but a couple of dry days leading upto the race day made sure the surplus water was dried up – Just a few showers in the morning helped keep the dust down for most of the day!

The autos were first to take to the track, Daniel Chisholm was the one to try and catch, leading the class from the start and taking all three race wins, pulling as much as a 34 second lead over second place. Kyle McNicol took second place, and Ryan Thomson took third place.

Alexander Brown proved hard to beat in the 65cc class, getting into the front of the field and staying there, taking all three race wins and the overall. Aaron MacDonald took all three second positions by a safe margin, and the second overall. Scott Russell took the third position.

Due to numbers both 85cc classes were ran together, but scored separately. In the 85cc small wheel class, Conor Curran took top spot with all three race wins. Tara McLeod took second place and Lewis Campbell finished in third. Murray Clunie dominated the 85cc big wheel class taking all three race wins, finishing around 30 seconds ahead of second place in all three races. Reece Wilson and Jack Taylor battled for second and third throughout all three races, with Reece Wilson taking the higher position in the third race, and the second position overall. Jack Taylor finished in third.

Mark Perfect proved a point in the Youth 125/250F class, taking all three race wins by a big margin, leaving the rest of the pack to battle for second and third. Hannah McLeod took the second overall, by just one point over Ian Stewart, who finished in third.

In the Adult 125/250F class, Ryan McLean, Steven Craig and David Houston battled for the top three positions. Ryan McLean came out top, taking two of the three race wins. Steven Craig took the other race win, and the second overall. David Houston finished in third.

Sean MacDonald was the man to beat in the Adult Open class, taking all three race wins and the overall. Alisdair Brodie took the second spot, and Colin McLuckie finished in third.

Round 3 of the SYMCC club championship at Shiplaw is on the 8th of August 2010.
